Summer League

12u Baseball

1. Please know the general rules of the league that apply to all levels of baseball and softball
2. Managers will play with the ROSTER BAT/FREE SUBSTITUTION rule. ROSTER BATTING: Every age group for boys must bat their entire roster. They will be allowed free substitution during the game and any players arriving late must be added in the last position of the batting order.
3. Baseball should be junior high/high school baseball. Example - Wilson A1010
4. Pitching mound - 50 feet
5. Bases - 70 feet; must use safety base at 1st base
6. 8 runs maximum per inning except for 6th or last inning
7. Pitchers can only throw 75 pitches
 - a. If a pitcher reaches 75 pitches in the middle of an at bat, they may finish the at bat.
 - b. 60-75 pitches = 3 days of rest/ 40-59 = 2 days of rest/ 20-39 = 1 day of rest/1-19 = no days rest
 - i. Example - Player A throws 15 pitches, he can pitch the next day.
 - ii. Player B throws 21 pitches on Monday, he cannot pitch again until Wednesday
 - iii. Player C throws 41 pitches on Monday, he cannot pitch again until Thursday
 1. Days off are calendar days, not by hours
8. Games are 6 innings
9. Dropped 3rd strike is in effect
11. 1 umpire is required, but 2 is encouraged
12. Courtesy runner may be used for the pitcher and catcher. The last batted out must be used for the courtesy runner if all players are in the lineup. Otherwise, it must be a player not in the lineup.
13. The infield fly rule is in effect
14. 1 balk warning per pitcher
15. Players must follow IESA bat rules. Typically, the bat must have a BBCOR stamp on it
16. Runners may lead off and steal.
17. There is no limit on overthrows
18. Players must make an attempt to slide on close plays. If contact is made during a close play, the runner can be called out
