

SCRL Rules
Summer League
10u Baseball

1. Please know the general rules of the league that apply to all levels of baseball and softball
2. Managers will play with the ROSTER BAT/FREE SUBSTITUTION rule. ROSTER BATTING: Every age group for boys must bat their entire roster. They will be allowed free substitution during the game and any players arriving late must be added in the last position of the batting order.
3. Baseball should be a pony league/Little League baseball. Typically has raised seams, but can use a high school baseball.
4. Pitching mound - 44 feet
5. Bases - 60 feet; must use safety base at 1st base
6. 5 runs maximum per inning except for 6th or last inning
7. Pitchers can only throw 60 pitches
 - a. If a pitcher reaches 60 pitches in the middle of an at bat, they may finish the at bat.
 - b. 50-60 pitches = 3 days of rest/ 30-49 = 2 days of rest/ 16-29 = 1 day of rest/ 1-15 = no days rest
 - i. Example - Player A throws 15 pitches, he can pitch the next day.
 - ii. Player B throws 16 pitches on Monday, he cannot pitch again until Wednesday
 - iii. Player C throws 31 pitches on Monday, he cannot pitch again until Thursday
 1. Days off are calendar days, not by hours
8. Games are 6 innings
9. No dropped 3rd strike
11. 1 umpire is required, but 2 is encouraged
12. Courtesy runner may be used for the pitcher and catcher. The last batted out must be used for the courtesy runner if all players are in the lineup. Otherwise, it must be a player not in the lineup.
13. The infield fly rule is in effect
14. 1 balk warning per pitcher
15. Players may use any bat
16. Runners cannot lead off and steal
17. There is no limit on overthrows
18. Players must make an attempt to slide on close plays. If contact is made during a close play, the runner can be called out
19. No bat restrictions; no altered bats allowed (corked, shaved, rolled, etc.)
